This is the 2023 public disclosure report for IndyEnergy Issues, a Missouri nonprofit corporation.

Activities

IndyEnergy Issues engages in educational activities accomplished through a website, an online newsletter and periodic public forums – all with the idea of improving rates, operations and governance of Independence Power and Light.

We have a strong interest in the further development of renewable energy and reduction in the use of fossil fuels to produce electricity.

During 2023, there were 2,000 unique visitors to the website of which 441 have a computer addresses associated with Independence.

The website is <u>www.indyenergy.org</u>. The most visited page was on new power generation followed by the annual review of the 100 highest paid city employees.

IndyEnergy produced 19 online newsletters during 2023 and held one public forum during the year.

Finances

IndyEnergy is personally funded by its three organizers and does not engage in fund raising or accept outside contributions. It charges nothing for programs and information provided to the community. Its largest single expense was for its website.

Total 2023 cash expenditures were approximately \$300.
