

IndyEnergy Issues 2021 Annual Public Disclosure Report

This is the 2021 public disclosure report for IndyEnergy Issues, a Missouri non-profit corporation.

Activities

IndyEnergy Issues engages in educational activities accomplished through a website, an online newsletter and periodic public forums – all with the idea of improving rates, operations and governance of Independence Power and Light.

We have a strong interest in the further development of renewable energy and reduction in the use of fossil fuels to produce electricity.

During 2021, there were 1,200 unique visitors to the website www.indyenergy.org.

The most visited page was on the closure of the Blue Valley power plant followed by our annual review of the 100 highest paid city employees – two thirds which work for IPL.

IndyEnergy produced 15 online newsletters during 2021.

IndyEnergy did not hold any public forums during the year.

Finances

IndyEnergy is personally funded by its three organizers and does not engage in fund raising or accept outside contributions. It charges nothing for programs and information provided to the community.

Its largest single expense was for its website.

Total 2021 cash expenditures were approximately \$300.
